Financial Aid Opportunities for Incoming Freshmen

Incoming Freshmen Scholarships

Academic Scholarships:

Students who score at the 99th national percentile will be awarded a \$2000 non-renewable tuition scholarship.

McAuley Board of Trustees Scholarship:

A scholarship equivalent to 1/2 of tuition is awarded to one student annually. The scholarship is renewable provided the student maintains a 3.0 GPA and has an excellent disciplinary record. Students are invited to apply via their elementary school principal and must complete the scholarship application and demonstrate financial need.

Principal Scholarship:

Six (6) \$1000 non-renewable scholarships are available for incoming first year students who have been recognized for their leadership skills.

Tradition of Excellence:

\$500 non-renewable scholarships are available for students who are daughters/granddaughters/nieces of Mother McAuley High School/St. Xavier Academy alumnae.

Alumnae Faculty/Staff:

\$500 non-renewable scholarships are available for students who are daughters/granddaughters/nieces of Mother McAuley High School/St. Xavier Academy alumnae. Recipients must also demonstrate academic, service, and leadership potential.

Please note: In order to be considered for a Mother McAuley High School scholarship, the student must have tested at Mother McAuley High School on January 9, 2010.

Family Discounts

Mother McAuley

A \$500 tuition reduction is given for each additional daughter currently attending Mother McAuley High School.

Brother Rice

If a brother attends Brother Rice High School, a \$250 discount will be given to the sibling currently attending Brother Rice, and a \$250 discount will be given to one sibling attending McAuley.

Mother McAuley High School Tuition Awards

Mother McAuley High School distributed over \$400,000 in financial aid awards to students in the 2009-2010 school year. Financial aid grants are awarded based upon demonstrated financial need. Applicants must complete the Private School Aid Service (PSAS) application in order to be considered. Applications will be available online or through the McAuley Financial Aid Office beginning in February of 2010. The largest amount awarded is \$2500.

Work Grant

Students may earn a \$300 per year tuition credit by working in various school departments during the school year. A PSAS application must be submitted in order to be considered for these positions.

Please note: In order for a student to be awarded Mother McAuley High School financial aid, the student must have completed the registration process by submitting the required registration fee and tuition deposit.
