THE SUSAN MORRISSEY MEMORIAL AWARD FOR SERVICE

Susan Morrissey was a 1986 graduate of Mother McAuley. Susan’s commitment to live out her Christian life led her to take a leadership role as an officer in McAuley’s premier service group, *Action/Reaction*. She organized her fellow students to seek creative ways to address needs and serve others. In 1997, Susan died suddenly as a result of a car accident. Susan’s family has established the Susan Morrissey Memorial Award for Service in Susan’s memory to encourage young women to step outside of themselves and make a difference by serving the needs of their school, church, and community. The award will be a **\$750 scholarship** applicable toward tuition.
