MCAULEY INDUCTS STUDENTS INTO QUILL AND SCROLL SOCIETY

Mother McAuley High School inducted nine students into the Quill and Scroll International Honor Society for high school journalists. Quill and Scroll was developed by a group of high school publication advisors for the purpose of encouraging and rewarding individual achievements in journalism and allied fields.

In order to be considered for membership, students must meet specific requirements. Inductees must be a junior or senior whose academic standing is in the upper third of their class; they must have served on a school publication for at least a year and shown superior work; and they must have demonstrated a willingness to offer service to their school.

The ceremony also featured Supervising Producer for WGN TV Morning News Sandy Pudar, a 1995 graduate of McAuley. Pudar spoke to the students about her work and how her experiences at McAuley helped shape her career path.

Since its inception in 1926, Quill and Scroll has granted charters to more than 14,267 high schools. Chapters are active in both public and private high schools across the United States and in countries around the world. The society has more than one million "alumni" in all walks of life, many of them in distinguished careers in journalism.
