MCAULEY’S SADD MEMBERS PROMOTE “HUGS NOT DRUGS”

The members of Mother McAuley High School’s Chapter of SADD (Students Against Destructive Decisions) sponsored a SADD Awareness Week from March 9-13. The students spent the week promoting anti-drug behavior through announcements, videos, posters and activities.

Some of the activities included a “Day of the Dead” where students dressed in black to represent the teens that are killed every day from drunk driving, and a wear red day where members of the McAuley community wore red to demonstrate their solidarity with the members of SADD and anti-drug behavior.

Twenty-seven members of SADD also recently participated in the Operation Snowflake at Oak Lawn Hometown Middle School. The event promotes an “Anti-Drug” life-style and included a motivational speaker, several small group activities, and an all-school pledge to live in a positive manner.
