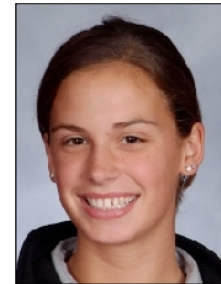

Sheila Burns of Beverly has been honored with a President's Volunteer Service Award for her exemplary volunteer service.



Sheila earned this award for her volunteer work at Christ Hospital in Oak Lawn. She has donated more than 400 hours of her time by volunteering once a week for the past two years. During her shift she has been assigned the duties of working the front desk, delivering flowers and packages to patients, transporting guests and patients and occasionally bringing the "activity cart" filled with books and games to patient's rooms.
