The Mother McAuley High School Theatre Department will present “Summer Brave” on January 28, 29, 30 at 7 pm with matinees on Saturday, January 30 at 3 pm and Sunday, January 31 at 3 pm. Tickets are \$4 and can be purchased at the door on the night of the performance.

“Summer Brave” by William Inge is the final version of the romantic comedy “Picnic.” Set in a small town in Kansas, it tells the story of a single mother and her two daughters, three schoolteachers, and a woman who takes care of her aging mother full time and the men who are in their lives. The play’s theme deals with the impetuosity of youth, the attraction between men and women, and the realization by the older characters that life is about to pass them by. The play masterfully blends both touching and humorous elements through which the lesson of growing up, going-on, and accepting what fate imposes.
