- Juniors and seniors are allowed to purchase their Parking Permit starting August 20th, in the hallway outside the Dining Hall, from 8:00 to 3:00 p.m. Permits not purchased or claimed by the end of the day on August 22nd, will be given to students on the waiting list.

Study Periods/Open Periods:

- <u>Freshman and Sophomore students</u> assigned to study hall periods are expected to report to the room/area listed on the student schedule. Freshmen and sophomores will not be allowed to arrive late or leave early even if study is assigned period one or nine.
- <u>Junior and Senior students</u> who have an "open" 2nd period **must** report to the Student Lounge for attendance and prayer.

General Information:

- > Attendance is mandatory for all students
- > Students should dress casually. You should not wear your uniform. (First day for uniforms is August 27, 2018)
- > Seniors, juniors, and sophomores should bring their lock
- > Replacements for lost schedules can be obtained from the level dean for a \$5.00 fee
- > Any approved schedule changes will incur a fee of \$100.00

<u>When purchasing items</u>: Students will need separate checks or cash for all items purchased: Ventra Cards, Replacement I.D., Parking Permit, and P.E. Clothing. Checks should be made payable to **Mother McAuley High School**.

<u>Physical Education Uniform and Physical Education Locks</u>: Students taking Physical Education courses can purchase their P.E. uniforms, starting August 20th in the West Gym, or during the first week of class. Cost: Shorts are \$13.00; and T-Shirts are \$9.00. Sizes range from Small to 2XL. P.E. locks will be distributed to all P.E. students in class on August 21st.

Student Handbook: Will be distributed to all students as they arrive in the Dining Hall for their lunch period, on August 21st.

Buses: Student Ventra Cards will be sold for \$2.00 throughout the school year, in the Main Office. They can be loaded at station vending machines, online, by phone or at more than 1,000 retailers and currency exchanges around town.

<u>Parking Permits</u>: Seniors and juniors who have been awarded a parking permit should bring a check for \$200.00 (payable to Mother McAuley High School) along with your driver's license, to the Main Office on August 20th, from 8:00 to 3:00 p.m. Permits not purchased or claimed by the end of the day on August 22nd, will be given to students on the waiting list. Students should be prepared to complete a registration card, including the license plate number, make and color of the vehicle.

<u>I.D.s</u>: All students are required to wear their student I.D. on the McAuley lanyard. Freshman students will receive their I.D. during orientation. Any other student who has lost her I.D. must purchase a replacement in the Main Office on August 21st. The cost for a new I.D. is \$6.00, replacement lanyard is \$2.00, and plastic I.D. holder is \$1.00. I.D.s will be checked on August 22nd, the first day of school.

<u>Uniforms</u>: All students are to begin wearing uniforms on Monday, August 27th. If additional uniform items are needed, please contact *Schoolbelles* at (708) 598-8008, located at 7763 S. Harlem Ave., Bridgeview, IL.

<u>Dining Room and Student Lounge</u>: All students are to eat lunch in the student Dining Hall. Once finished, students are welcome to stay in the Dining Hall to continue socializing or they may bring or buy packaged snacks and contained drinks while congregating in the Student Lounge. Remember to make each person feel welcomed and help each other, especially freshmen, find a place.
