


The Jan Malloy Scholarship for Spirit and McAuley Community Involvement



Jan Malloy was an integral part of the Mother McAuley family. She served as the Alumnae Coordinator for eight years and was a true Mighty Mac. Jan was often seen at games cheering on the athletic teams, greeting families at open house or welcoming alumnae back for a reunion. Her love for McAuley was evident in each task. In September 2009, Jan passed away after a long illness and we miss her spirit, laughter, and energy.

Jan was instrumental in creating several scholarships to help students receive a quality education in the tradition of the Sisters of Mercy. These scholarships honor or memorialize loved ones in the McAuley community. With that in mind Jenny Costello Fortner '94, and her husband P. Jay Fortner, have established the ***Jan Malloy Scholarship for Spirit and McAuley Community Involvement***. This scholarship will be given to a current sophomore or junior who demonstrates the McAuley spirit and is actively involved in the McAuley community.

In order to be considered for this scholarship, a student must demonstrate financial need and be in good standing both academically (minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5) and behaviorally. Students applying are asked to interview a Mother McAuley alumna to whom they are not related and answer the questions below. Students are also required to write an essay about their involvement in the McAuley community. Essays should be 400 – 500 words, type-written in 12 point font, double spaced. The form below should be signed by the student, her parent/guardian and her dean and attached to the front of the essay.

Two applicants will be selected to each receive a **\$1,000** tuition scholarship. For more information, please contact Mrs. Kathy Klyczek in the Financial Aid office.
