The Susan Morrissey Memorial Award for Service

Susan Morrissey was a 1986 graduate of Mother McAuley. Susan's commitment to live out her Christian life led her to take a leadership role as an officer in McAuley's premier service group, Action/Reaction. She organized her fellow students to seek creative ways to address needs and serve others. In 1997, Susan died suddenly as a result of a car accident. Susan's family has established The Susan Morrissey Memorial Award for Service in Susan's memory to encourage young women to step outside of themselves and make a difference by serving the needs of their school, church, and community.

The award will be a \$750 tuition scholarship awarded to a current freshman student. **APPLICATIONS ARE DUE FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 23, 2018.**

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. The applicant must be a current freshman student.
2. The applicant must have achieved a B average (minimum of 3.0 G.P.A.) in their first semester of high school.
3. The applicant must demonstrate financial need as shown through the FAST financial aid application.
4. The applicant must answer all of the following questions. Answers should be numbered 1-4, typed in a 12-point font, and double-spaced. Please do not put your name or any identifying information on your answer sheet. Please attach your responses to this application page.
 1. *Why do you think service to others is important?*
 2. *What need did you recognize, what plan did you develop to address that need, and what specific steps did you take to actualize the plan?*
 3. *How has your understanding of service changed/developed during your first year at McAuley? How does your understanding connect with the value Catherine McAuley placed on service?*
 4. *How will you continue to make service to others matter at Mother McAuley High School?*
